What is SLCGP

- Grant created by the State & Local Cybersecurity Improvement act through US Department of Homeland Security.
- 1\$ Billion to be awarded over a 4-year grant life-cycle
- Administered by FEMA & CISA
- Administered locally by MSP/EMHSD and DTMB Michigan Cybersecurity
- Established to assist local governments reduce cyber risk, improve security of critical infrastructure and improve resilience of services SLT governments provide to their community

SLCGP Participation The Who & the When

We strongly encourage participation from every organization, although participation is voluntary. The Committee acknowledges that it will not be able to fund all requests and may need to limit funding available to any specific project requests.

Who Can Apply? - Joni Harvey

All state and local government entities are eligible to participate in the SLCGP including:

1. A county, municipality, city, town, township, local public authority, school district, special district, intrastate district, council of governments, regional or interstate government entity, or agency or instrumentality of a local government.
2. Authorized Tribal governments and organizations | TCGP
3. A rural community, unincorporated town or village, or other public entity

Requirements

All state and local government entities are eligible to participate in the SLCGP including:

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Post Award Requirements

Eligible organizations that receive services or sub-grant funding are required to participate in post grant award activities

1. Cyber Hygiene Services -
 - Web Application Scanning
 - Vulnerability ScanningBoth Services are available through CISA
2. Participation in the NCSR – National
Both services are available through CISA

What is Supplanting Funds & Why does it matter

Supplanting

If something is already appropriated in the budget at the State or Local level for the same item(s) the grant funds will be covering, the grant funds **cannot** be used to replace those appropriated dollars.

If you are increasing what's already been appropriated at the State or Local level, you can use grant funds. i.e., expanding, enhancing; anything "on top of" is okay, but it cannot be replaced.

Two key words with supplanting are appropriated and replaced.

Enhancing/upgrading an existing system is supplementing, not *supplanting*.

Supplementing is allowable for this grant. **Supplanting is NOT.**

SLCGP 4-Year Lifecycle

- 48 Months Performance & Spend Periods
- Funding from 2022-2029

1st Grant Year 2022

- Lifecycle from September 2022 – end of September 2026

4 Grant Years

- 48 Months Performance & Spending periods
- Award notifications not made yet
- Anticipated lifecycle from 2023-2027

Many Rounds of Funding

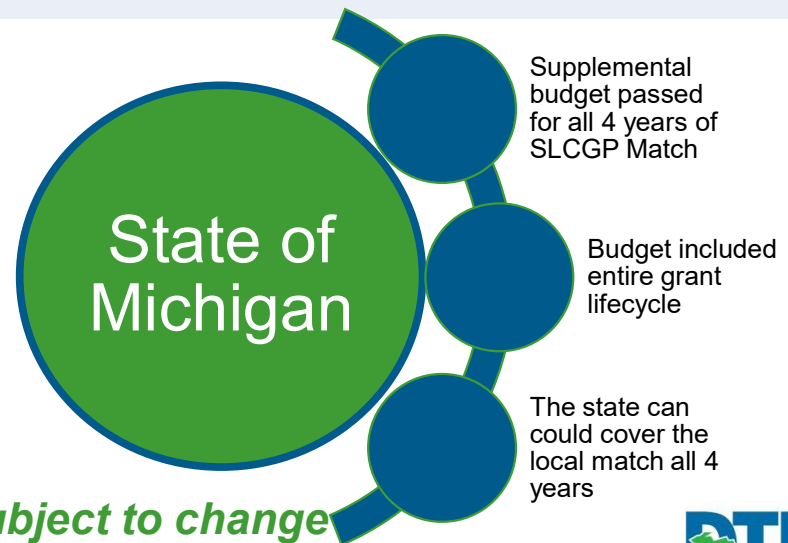

What can the funds be used for?

SLCGP Panel Conversation

Acceptable use of Funding

Funds must be used for projects that align with the State & Local Cybersecurity Grant program goals and objectives

1. Cybersecurity Assessments
2. Purchase of MFA Tokens / Keys
3. Endpoint detection and Response Subscriptions/Licensing
4. Network Monitoring Solutions
5. Services to Migrate to the .GOV Domain
6. Dedicated funding to provide training for our cybersecurity professionals
7. Costs for cybersecurity services provided by Managed Service Providers

Just a few examples that align with the cybersecurity plan, and grant objectives.

The Cybersecurity Planning Committee

Determines what projects will be funded by the State & Local Cybersecurity Grant Program

1. Responsible for ensuring that projects align with the cybersecurity plan and grant objectives.
2. Determine if projects meet one or more of the 16 required elements of the cybersecurity plan.
3. Determine if projects fall under one of the four grant objectives

Is funding a good fit for local school districts?

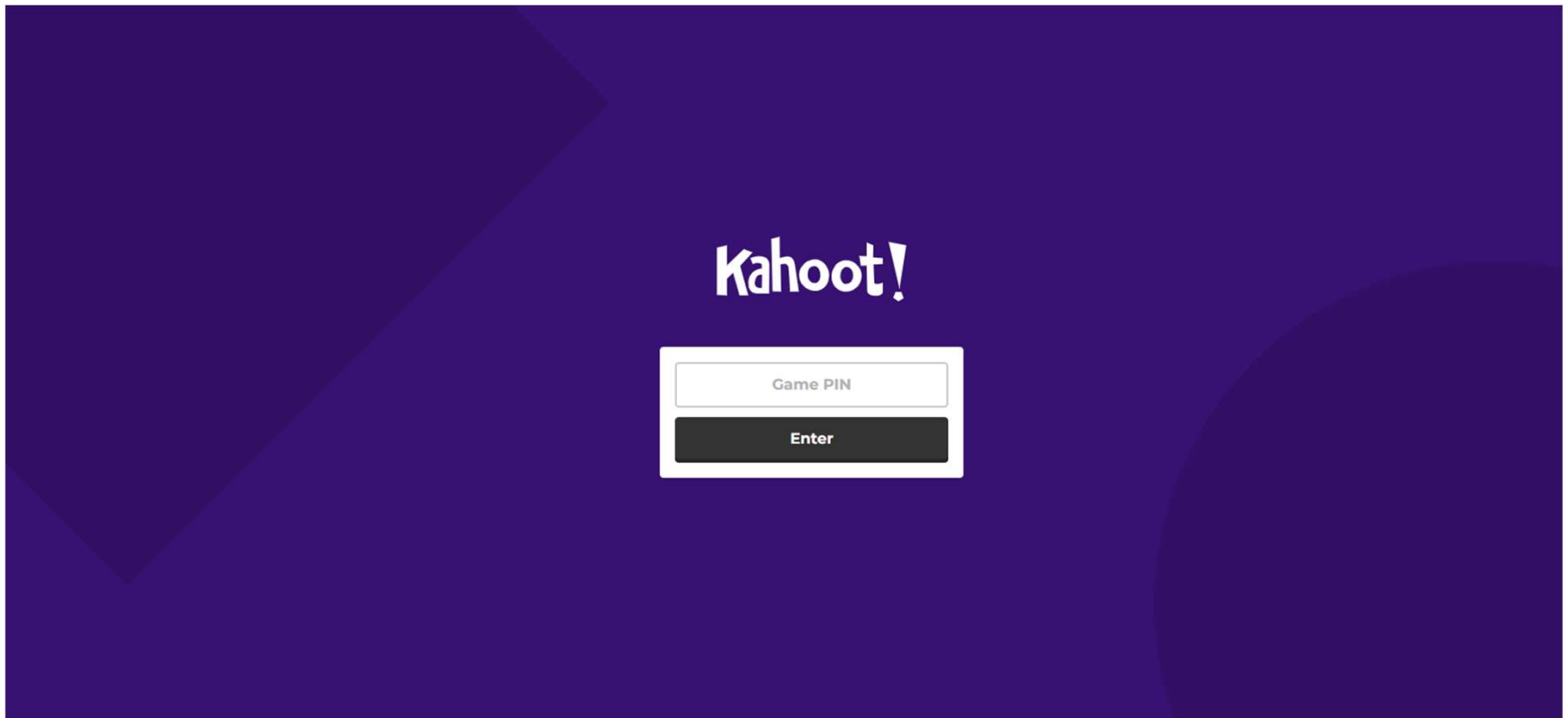
YES This is a great program for us to work with the school districts on.
